# Highlights of our trip...



**Times Square** is a major commercial intersection in the borough of Manhattan in New York City. For more than a century, Times Square has been a center for performance and the arts – the crossroads where actors, musicians, and comedians have come to seize the stage and seek the spotlight. Times Square boasts one of the world's most concentrated theater districts and certainly its most renowned, as Broadway continues to lure today's top stars to its productions. We will spend three days and two nights in this "Wonderful Town" where we will enjoy the sites, good food, and shopping.

## Broadway & Top of the Rock

Our tour includes reserved seat tickets to the Broadway Hit *The Lion King*. The Serengeti comes to life as never before through the extraordinary vision that is *The Lion King*. More than 50 million people have felt the thrill of this Tony Award winner for Best Musical, which tells the classic journey of young royal heir Simba. Giraffes strut, birds swoop and gazelles leap in a dazzling panorama that overwhelms the senses and inspires you with the wonder of life. This is *The Lion King*. Imagination Untamed.



We will end the evening seeing the city lights from the Top of the Rock - reserved ticket included. Soar 70 floors high and experience the exhilarating joy of unobstructed 360° city views from the Top of the Rock Observation Deck in Rockefeller Plaza, high above NBC Studios. Nowhere else can you see this thrilling skyline of New York City so spectacularly.

## Statue of Liberty and Ellis Island



We will depart Battery Park via ferry to visit Liberty and Ellis Islands-reserved ticket included. The Statue of Liberty was a gift of friendship from the people of France to the people of the United States and is a universal symbol of freedom and democracy. We will see the Statue of Liberty National Monument, have time to explore the Immigration Museum and the halls and galleries at Ellis Island where more than 12 million immigrants first entered America.

## 9/11 Memorial



Our tour will take us to The National September 11 Memorial that is a tribute of remembrance and honor to the nearly 3,000 people killed in the terror attacks

of September 11, 2001 at the World Trade Center site, near Shanksville, Pa., and at the Pentagon, as well as the six people killed in the World Trade Center bombing in February 1993. The Memorial's twin reflecting pools are each nearly an acre in size and feature the largest manmade waterfalls in the North America. The pools sit within the footprints where the Twin Towers once stood. The names of every person who died in the 2001 and 1993 attacks are inscribed into bronze panels edging the Memorial pools, a powerful reminder of the largest loss of life resulting from a foreign attack on American soil and the greatest single loss of rescue personnel in American history. **The Ground Zero Museum Workshop - reserved ticket included**, features stunning images, rare video and remnants from the Ground Zero Recovery Period, all packed into an intimate and emotional space. We will meet the photographer, and experience a guided tour through the exhibit. On display are 100 of Gary Marlon Suson's most well-known images, including the charred Genesis 11: Tower of Babylon Bible Page found in the WTC rubble, the Frozen Clock stuck at 10:02am, marking the collapse of the South Tower and several FDNY Honor Guard images. You will also be allowed the rare opportunity to pick up and hold World Trade Center steel and window glass.
